Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the IOC, Panam Sports, plus the rules of the ISA, may participate in the Pan American Games 2023.

Quota places are allocated to the athlete(s) by name. The hierarchy of the qualifying events will be as follows:

- ISA Events (2023 World Surfing Games, 2023 World Longboard, 2022 World SUP)
- 2023 PASA Games
- 2022 ALAS Tour Ranking

In case the allocation goes to an NOC that has already met their maximum quota, the results from ISA Event(s) will prevail and the place from the 2023 PASA Games or 2022 ALAS Tour will be reallocated to the next highest-ranked eligible athlete at the respective event.

In the event there is a tie in the ranking when determining the highest placed eligible athlete, the athlete with the highest heat-score total from their final heat in the respective event will obtain the quota place.







Top Ranking

Qualification for the Pan Am Games 2023 is contingent upon an athlete placing within the top ranking at the respective Qualification Event. The quality top ranking is defined as follows: **PASA Games:**

- Shortboard: Having finished within the top 20
- SUP Surf: Having finished within the top 16
- SUP Race: Having finished within the top 16
- Longboard: Having finished within the top 16

ALAS Pro Tour:

• Shortboard: Having finished within the top 16

If there are no eligible athletes that finish within the quality top ranking listed above, the place will be reallocated to the next highest ranked eligible athlete at the 2023 ISA World Surfing Games.

Host Country Places

If athletes from the host country have earned a quota place(s) through the Qualification System listed above, the relevant host country place(s) will be allocated to the next highest-ranked eligible athlete at the respective event, respecting the maximum quota places per NOC.

Confirmation of quotas

The ISA, in coordination with PASA will confirm to Panam Sports and to the CONs the quota places they have qualified no later than July 3rd, 2023.

The NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports, **the ISA and PASA** the places they will use no later than July 7th, 2023.

Reallocation of unused quota places

If necessary, no later than July 10th, 2023, **the ISA in coordination with PASA** will reallocate unused quota places to the next best positioned NOC that has not qualified yet.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than July 14th, 2023.

Qualification for the Paris 2024 Olympic Games

In Surfing, the gold medalists in the Shortboard event will qualify by name* to the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. If any of the gold medalists are already qualified by athlete name or their NOC has already filled its quota, the quota place will be allocated to the next highest-ranked eligible athlete*.
